

## Testimonial

We were in Ocean City, Maryland for the weekend to celebrate St. Patrick's Day. We got into the rented condo with our two rotties. Cutter is 22 months and Jade is 10 months. We left Cutter at the condo and took Jade with us when we went out to eat.

When we came back I took Cutter and Jade for an evening walk. It was about 9:45 and very dark outside. Jade got away from me just as a car sped around the corner. She was hit, the car didn't stop. She ran off, and it took a while to find her. We called 911 and we were directed to the Salisbury Animal Hospital (it was a 40 minute drive away).

She didn't have any broken bones or internal injuries. However, she was in very bad shape. She lost all her toe nails on the front paws, and most of the skin in all four paws (her paw skin was stapled together). She had road burn all under her belly and legs. The Hospital kept her overnight.

The next day we picked her up and the wounds were already showing extensive healing. The Vet gave us the Pavia Natural Wound Care Cream and told us to put it on twice a day.

She is making remarkable progress. We took her back to our home that day and to see our own Vet. He had never heard of the Pavia wound cream. He gave us something else to use.
